Ash Wednesday Liturgy for the Imposition of Ashes

- P Lord, you are merciful to all, and hate nothing you have created. You overlook our sins to bring us to repentance.
- C You are the Lord our God.
- P Lord, protect us in our struggle against evil. As we begin the discipline of Lent, make this day holy—set apart—by an awareness of our own mortality, by a heartfelt desire to repent and amend our lives, and by the promise of your grace and forgiveness. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.
- C Amen.
- P Dear friends in Christ, let us ask our Father to bless these ashes which we will use as the mark of our repentance. Let us pray. Almighty and eternal God, you have mercy on all, and hate nothing you have made. You overlook the sins of those who repent and are weighed down by sin. Bless + and sanctify those who receive these ashes. Like the Ninevites, we will bear these ashes on our foreheads as a sign of our repentance and our desire for forgiveness.

May our observance of this season, which we begin by our devotion this day, purify our hearts and lives, in preparation for the joy of Easter now, and the everlasting glory of the life to come. We ask this through Christ our Lord.
